

REGULATION OF MAWHOT'DURO 2019 At the bike park of Tournavaux

Event mountain bike,

Article 1: date, time and place

The event will take place on the weekend of 18-19 May 2018 from Tournavaux town hall, 08800.

Schedule: 18: 9h-16h

Schedule: 19: 8h-13h. The site will not be secure outside these times, so you must respect them.

Article 2: Participation

Opening of the endurando for all over 14 years old (minor accompanied by a legal representative, or with a signed parental authorization to give when removing plaque).

Article 3: Course

It is an enduro, enduro without chrono, descending and difficult profile, accompanied by loopholes as needed.

Approximately 20 km, per 1,000 meters of elevation gain.

It is clear to the participants to scrupulously respect the course.

The departure of the drivers at the special stage, will be timed through volunteers, to smooth their descent and reduce the risk of collision.

Other volunteers will be present throughout the course to ensure safety at difficult portions, crossing and others.

A refueling will be put in place and the participants will be able to stop there several times during the course.

The participant undertakes not to broadcast the GPS track, which he would have recorded.

Article 4: Registration / Regulation

The mountain biker must, in order to participate in this event, pay $12 \in$ of registration for 1 day or $18 \in$ for the weekend before 05 May 2019.

As of May 05 midnight, this amount will be increased to € 17 for 1 day and € 23 for the weekend.

Payment and registration will be via a dedicated website with payment by credit card.

Article 5: Reimbursement of the event

No refunds will be made as of May 1, 2019.

In the event of cancellation of the Mawhot'duro event, the Mawhot mtb association undertakes to fully refund the participants to date of their payment, either 12 or 18 €.

Article 6: Reception

The participant will have to present himself at the reception to validate his departure and to recover a numbered plate which will give him access to the specials and the refueling.

Article 7: Mtb

The participant agrees to ride with a mountain bike in good working order and secure (hanger cap, brake, tire ...) and in line with the practice of enduro.

Article 8: Protection and equipment of the pilot

Wearing the full-face helmet, gloves, a backpack with a water bag or backpack, knee pads and elbow pads are more than highly recommended.

It is also advisable to have enough food, drink, mtb repair and treatment.

Article 9: Environment

The participant must respect the course and its surroundings, whether the road, wide roads or singles in the woods, and should in no case deposit any waste.

The participant agrees to respect others (pilots, volunteers, spectators, organizers ...).

Article 10: Right to the image

The participant authorizes the use by the association Mawhot mtb of any photographic or video support, recording on the internet ...

Article 11: Other

You agree to respect the rules of the road.

You admit that this event involves risks (eg weather, road traffic, very steep wooded course, collision between participants, fall ...), declare to be physically fit and able to justify insurance (civil liability for example or other if necessary).

The association Mawhot mtb, its partners, volunteers and leaders disclaim any liability in case of accident, loss or theft.

The participant therefore assumes full responsibility for any accident whatsoever during this event day.

I agree that the organizers can exclude me from the event in case of non-respect of these articles.
